OHIO ASTHMA FAST FACTS

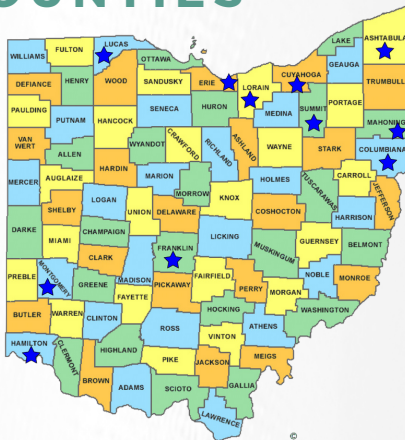
- Nearly **190,000** Ohio children under the age of 18 have asthma.
